### What is DustJel?

DustJel is a concentrated polymer liquid dispersion, a water extender. Its main use is to stop dust on trafficable areas. It is nontoxic to flora and fauna. biodegradable and an environmentally friendly product. DustJel can be used on open areas as well but Rainstorm provides more affordable solutions.

DustJel is easy to apply, very cost effective and safe to use. It can be applied at any time during the year. It works best on roads in combination with our other product, DustMag.

# **Benefits of DustJel**

It will stabilise the road surface on both haul and access roads by binding road base particles together. That reduces the need for water up to 60%.

It is a short term solution to prevent wind erosion on open areas or stockpiles.

## How long will it last?

When used on roads, DustJel is applied in extremely small doses so it needs to be reapplied a few times per day.

On open areas DustJel can last up to a month.

### **Application**

DustJel is added to the water cart as part of an ongoing dust management plan. It can be applied at a ratio as low as 1L per 50,000L of water

With the addition of Rainstorm's in-house designed and build dosing systems, application couldn't be simpler. It is set up to feed DustJel through the your standpipe at the required dosing rate. Contact your Rainstorm representative for more information.
